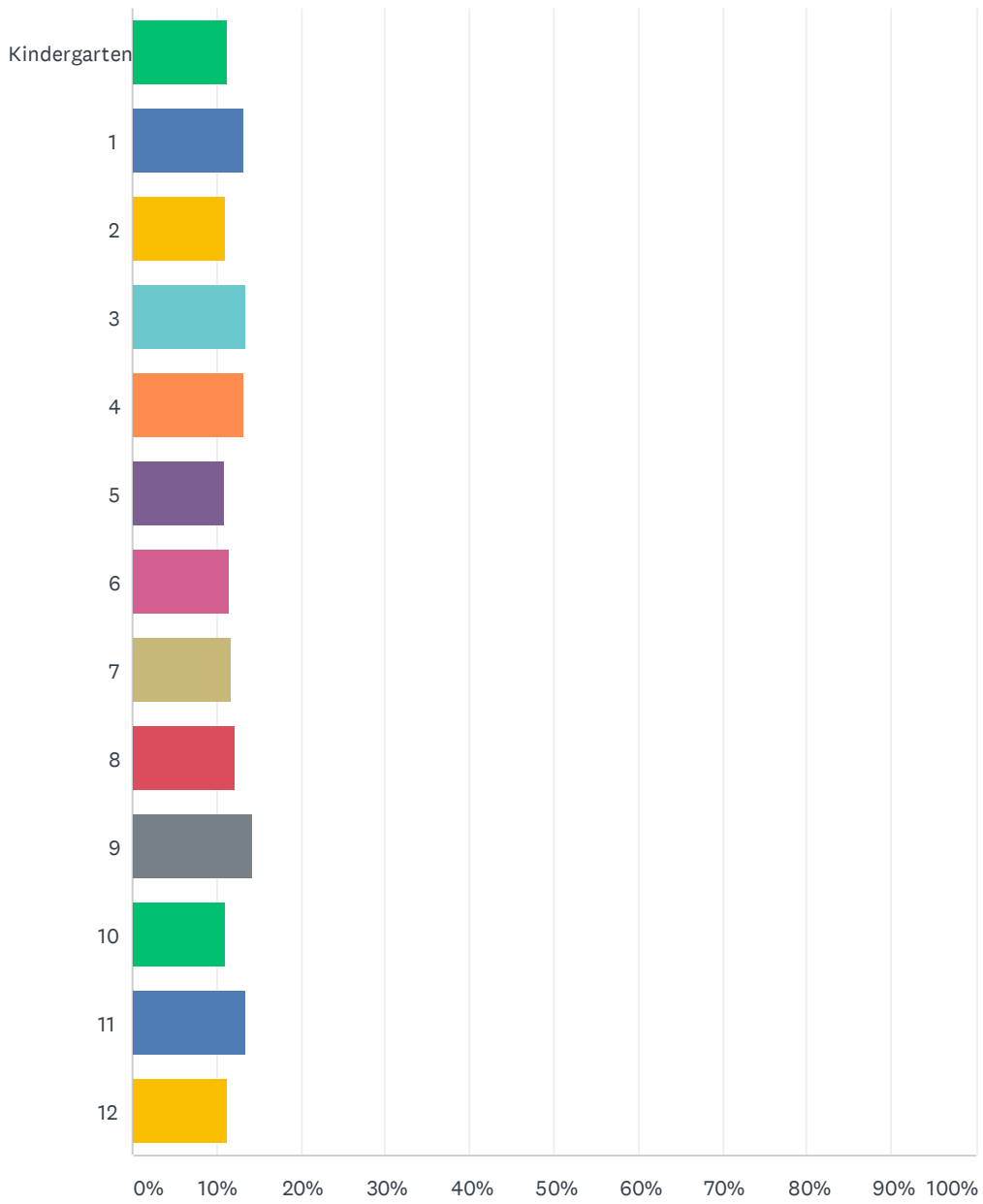


Q1 I will have a child/children in the following grades in the 2020-21 school year.

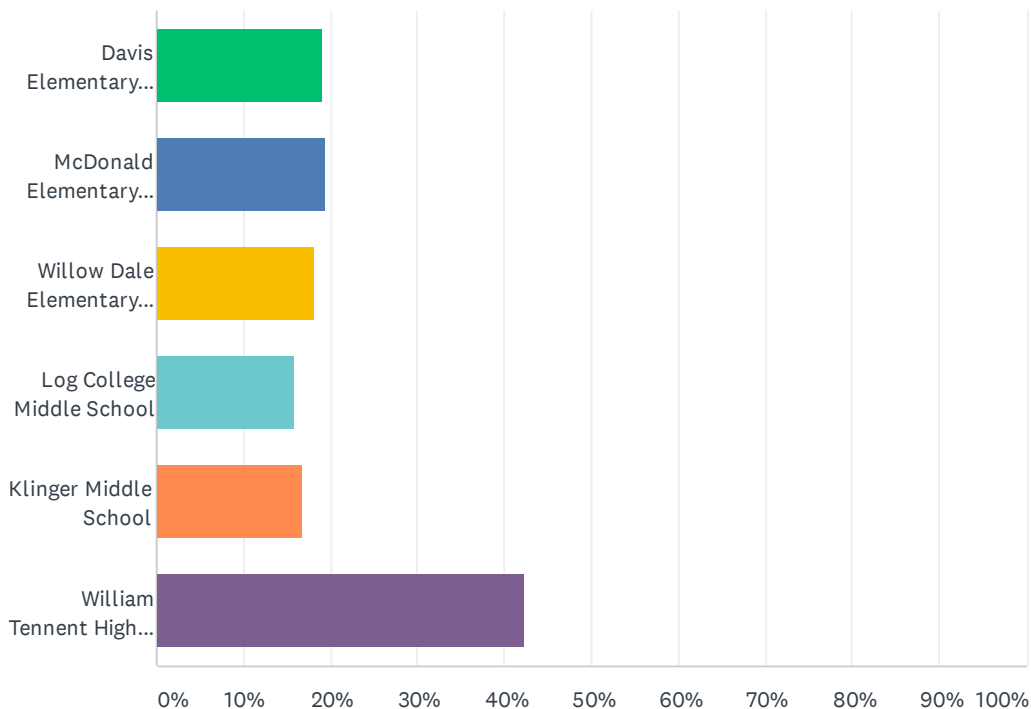

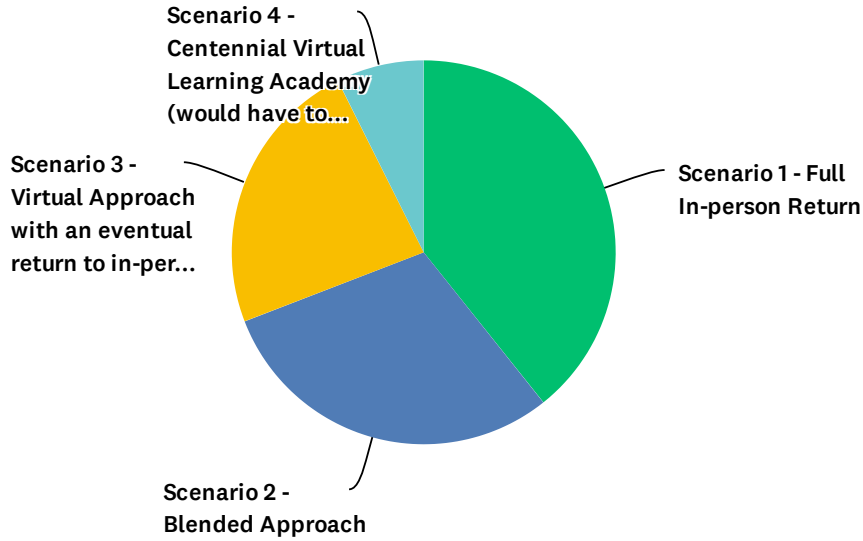

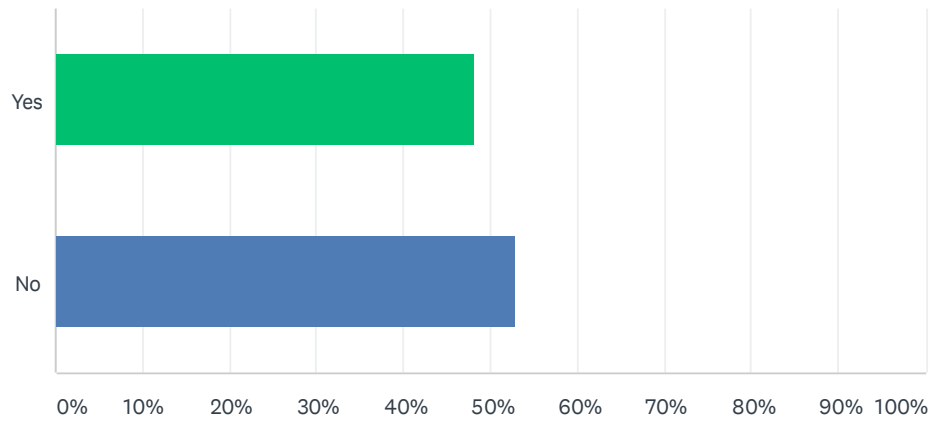

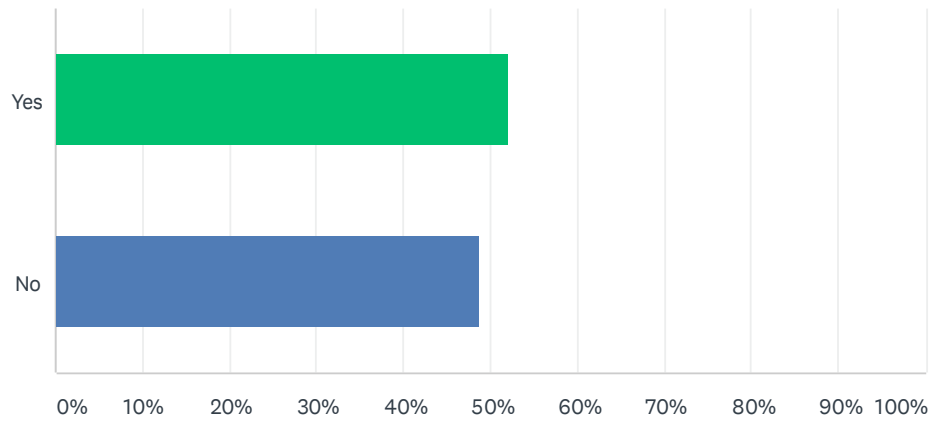

Q5 After reading the program description I am inclined to use district transportation in the Blended scenario.

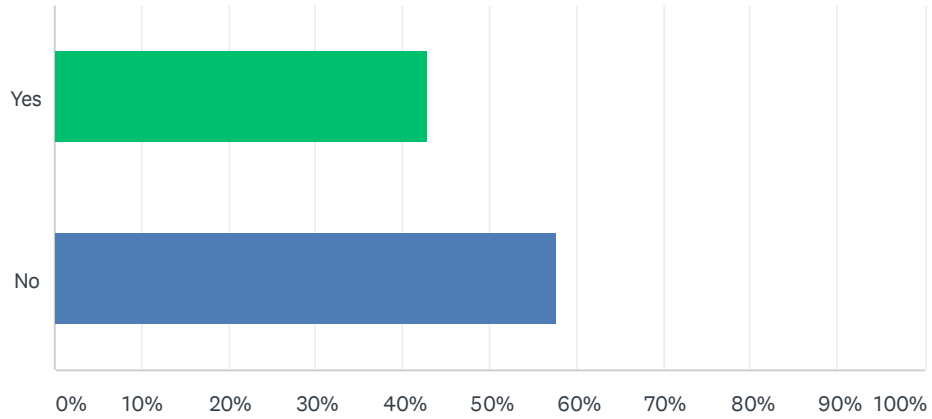

Q6 I am not inclined to use district transportation to and from school due to my concern about social distancing on a school bus.

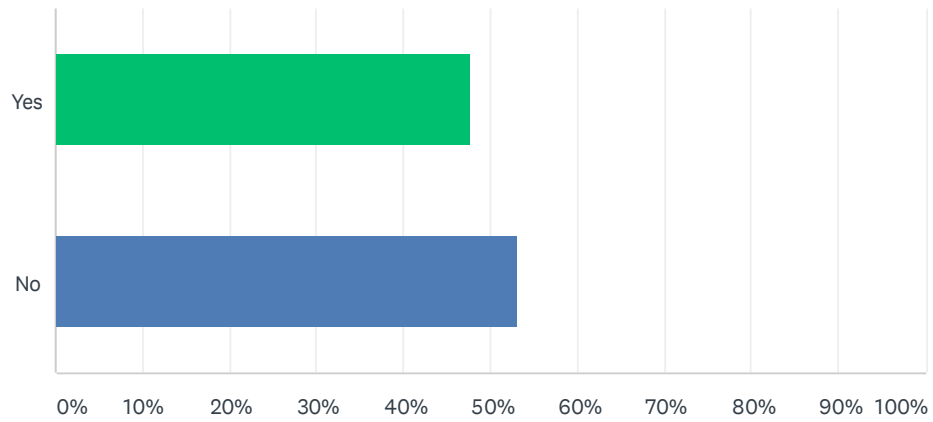

Q7 I will transport my child or he/she will walk to school next year regardless of the scenario the district implements.

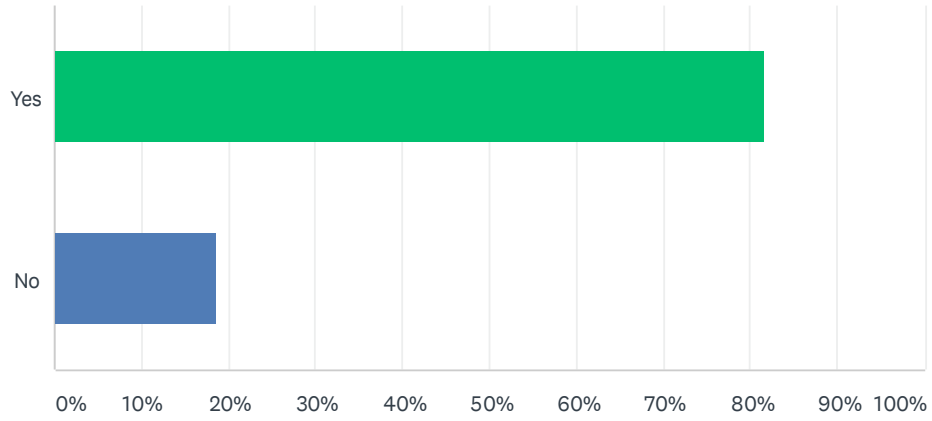

Q8 I would be interested in obtaining a free face shield if the Centennial School District offers one for my child(ren).

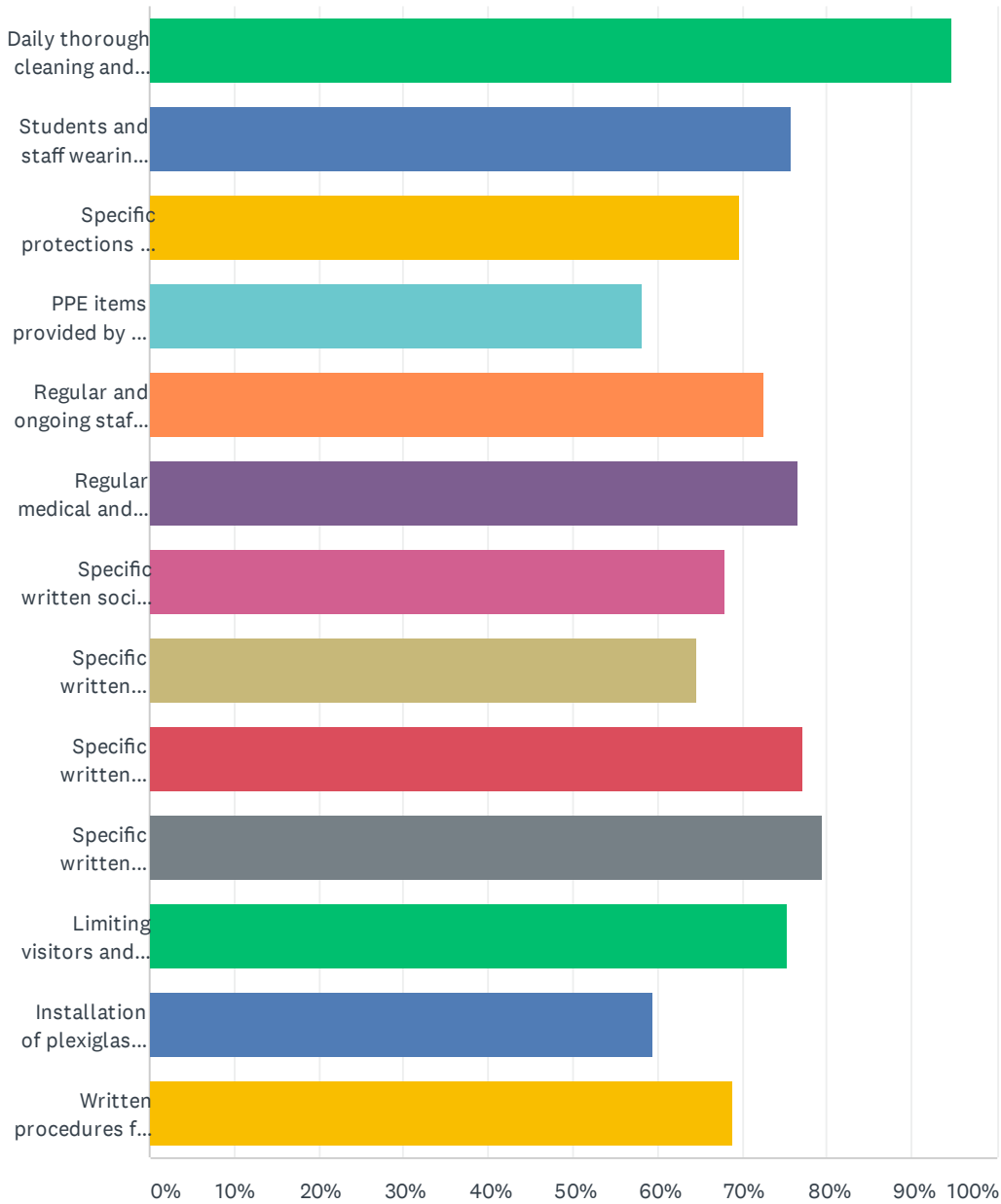
