

ACT 126 MANDATED REPORTER TRAINING FAQs

Q: I already took the GCN modules “An Introduction to Act 126” and “Child Abuse Awareness,” do I still need to complete the three (3) hour Act 126 training?

A: Yes, all employees must complete three (3) hours of Act 126 Mandated Reporter training. The GCN modules, “An Introduction to Act 126” and “Child Abuse Awareness,” only counts towards 30 minutes of the three (3) hour training requirement.

Q: I already took the GCN modules “An Introduction to Act 126” and “Child Abuse Awareness,” can I only do 2 hours and 30 minutes of Act 126 training?

A: No. There are no Act 126 trainings that are 2 hours and 30 minutes long. All employees must complete three (3) hours of Act 126 Mandated Reporter training.

Q: Do I have to choose the in-person training?

A: No, although the District strongly encourages the interactive in-person training as employees will be able to engage in discussion, participate in activities, and ask questions. However, employees may choose to view the online training.

Q: The in-person training sessions are full, will there be additional dates offered in the future?

A: Yes, additional dates will be offered throughout the school year and summer. Please check the CSD Human Resources website (<http://www.centennialsd.org/Page/7283>) as additional dates will be added throughout the year/summer.

Q: I already completed a three (3) hour Act 126 Mandated Reporter training, what do I do?

A: If you already completed a three (3) hour Act 126 Mandated Reporter training, you must complete the Act 126 Augmented Mandated Reporter Training form and return it to Human Resources.

Q: When do I need to complete the three (3) hour Act 126 Mandated Reporter training by?

A: The deadline to complete the three (3) hour Act 126 Mandated Reporter training is December 31, 2017. All employees will be required to complete three (3) hours of training every five years thereafter.

Q: Am I allowed to view the online training from home?

A: Yes, all employees who choose the online training option may view it from home. Support Staff who view the online training from home will be compensated three (3) hours and must also submit a Supplemental Time Sheet (attached) to Human Resources. Support Staff who view the free online course during working hours will not receive additional compensation.
