Assistant Secretary

Mr. Grossi requested nominations for Assistant Secretary.

A motion was made by Mrs. Jankowsky and seconded by Mr. Strouse to nominate Mr. Faust as Assistant Secretary.

A motion was made by Mrs. Huf and seconded by Mrs. Jankowsky to close the nominations. The motion passed 8-0.
