PLEDGE OF ALLEGIANCE

Mrs. Lynch led the group in the Pledge of Allegiance.

Mr. Blatt presented a plaque to Mrs. Lynch recognizing her service to the Centennial School District as Board President.

ELECTION OF TEMPORARY PRESIDENT

Mrs. Lynch asked for nominations for Temporary President.

A motion was made by Mrs. Huf and seconded by Mrs. Baranski to approve appointing Mrs. Lynch as Temporary President.

A motion was made by Mrs. Huf and seconded by Mrs. Gold to close the nominations.

The motion to close nominations passed 8-0.

The motion to elect Mrs. Lynch as Temporary President passed 8-0.

ELECTION OF OFFICERS

President

Mrs. Lynch requested nominations for the office of President.

A motion was made by Mrs. Mueller to nominate Mr. Faust as President. Mr. Faust declined the nomination.

A motion was made by Mrs. Huf and seconded by Mrs. Gold to nominate Mrs. Lynch as President.

A motion was made by Mrs. Huf and seconded by Mrs. Gold to close the nominations. The motion to close passed 9-0.

A roll call vote was taken as follows:

The motion passed 6-3.

Vice President

Mrs. Lynch requested nominations for the office of Vice President.

A motion was made by Mr. Grossi and seconded by Mrs. Jankowsky to nominate Mrs. Mueller as Vice President.

A motion was made by Mrs. Gold and seconded by Mrs. Baranski to nominate Mrs. Huf as Vice President.

Mrs. Jankowsky pointed out that the policy called for the President and Vice President to be from different townships. Mrs. Lynch pointed out that the policy stated “if possible.”

Mrs. Brzezinski indicated that Mrs. Huf represented Ivyland. Mrs. Jankowsky stated that Ivyland was not a township. She felt that Mrs. Huf would do a wonderful job, but she was just pointing out what the policy stated.

A motion was made by Mrs. Brzezinski and seconded by Mrs. Gold to close the nominations.

The motion to close the nominations passed 9-0.

A roll call vote was taken as follows (as to the nomination of Mrs. Mueller):

The motion to elect Mrs. Mueller as Vice President failed 3-6.

A roll call vote was taken as follows (as to the nomination of Mrs. Huf):

<i>Mrs. Mueller</i>	<i>No</i>	<i>(Mrs. Mueller stated that she did not think the Board was following policy.)</i>

The motion to elect Mrs. Huf as Vice President passed 6-3.

Assistant Secretary

Mrs. Lynch requested nominations for the office of Assistant Secretary.

A motion was made by Mrs. Jankowsky and seconded by Mrs. Huf to nominate Mrs. Mueller as Assistant Secretary.

A motion was made by Mrs. Jankowsky and seconded by Mr. Grossi to close the nominations.

The motion to close nominations passed 9-0.

A motion was made by Mr. Grossi and seconded by Mrs. Jankowsky to elect Mrs. Mueller by acclamation.

The motion to elect Mrs. Mueller by acclamation passed 8-1. (Mrs. Brzezinski was opposed.)

Mrs. Huf commented that she felt that all three regions were represented in the officers.

COMMITTEES

Mrs. Lynch stated that committee assignments and appointments would be made on December 14th. She also announced that there would be an Education Committee Meeting at 8:00 p.m. this evening.

ADJOURNMENT

A motion was made by Mrs. Huf and seconded by Mrs. Gold to adjourn the meeting. The motion passed 9-0. The meeting was adjourned at 7:50 p.m.
