NEW BUSINESS

1. Set Date of William Tennent High School Graduation

Mrs. Mueller stated that prior to this meeting the Board had met with the Centennial Education Association to make sure we would be okay with the contract. Everyone has received a Memorandum of Understanding that they have agreed with June 16 and 17 as in-service days. The faculty has agreed to this as well. This will allow them to do Skyward.

Mrs. Homel indicated that on the second day the high school would work on AFG, the middle school would be working with teams, and the elementary schools with the literature series.

Mrs. Mueller stated that the support staff is comprised of many different groups and that this would be giving them a two-day start on their summer vacation.

Dr. Pollock asked how many hours in-service would be. Mrs. Mueller indicated that it would be 5½ hours per day.

Mr. Hezel pointed out that one of the reasons we wanted to push this back to Friday was to attach this to a weekend and make travel plans easier. Since this is two months away, some people may already have made airline reservations and could incur financial hardship if this was changed at this point. He felt that this should have been addressed sooner.

Mrs. Huf stated that she did not think that people go ahead with their plans until they know the final date since we never know the exact date because of snow days, etc. Mrs. Huf felt that the Board should go ahead with this.

Mrs. Mueller stated that this was the subject of a past Education Committee meeting.

A motion was made by Mrs. Mueller and seconded by Mrs. Huf to resolve that the Centennial School Board approves the date of Friday, June 13, 2008 as the date for William Tennent High School graduation for the 2007-2008 school year.

Be it further resolved that the final attendance day for students K-12 is Friday, June 13, 2008.

The motion passed 8-0.
