MINUTES of SCHOOL DIRECTOR INTERVIEWS  
HELD September 30, 2015

**1. CALL TO ORDER (Mrs. Schrader Lynch)**

A School Director Interviews Meeting of the Centennial School Board was held September 30, 2015 in the Administration Building. The meeting was called to order by Mrs. Lynch at 7:05 p.m.

**Interview Questions**

1. Why are you interested in serving on the School Board?
2. What qualities, skills and experience would you bring to the Board?
3. If you were faced with a tough issue as a Board member, such as raising taxes or cutting programs, what kind of data would you need to help you make your decision?
4. What is your concept of the role of a Board member?
