I strongly recommend we establish these facilities as eligible for transportation for each of the schools designated above. I believe this will provide ample options to all families within the district to choose a Day Care facility for which we will provide transportation services and still be able to maintain our routing standards and ensure timely services for all of our schools.

There would be no additional expense for these adjustments, as we are already providing transportation to/from all of these locations, with the exception of Children of America and School House Learning Center for Willow Dale. However, the vehicles that would be used are going past these locations during the normal route, therefore there would be no additional expense by incorporating them into the existing routes in the future.
