	<p style="text-align: center;">105.3. ANIMALS IN THE CLASSROOM FOR EDUCATIONAL PURPOSES</p> <p>1. Authority Subject to the terms, conditions and limitations set forth in applicable administrative regulations adopted by the Superintendent, teachers may have animals in the classroom for educational purposes. The Board recognizes that care and the appropriate use of animals in the classroom may enhance the educational experiences of students. Adequate safeguards shall be established to protect students and animals from injury and/or disease. Nothing in this policy shall be construed as giving any right to any student the right to bring an animal to school. Instead, the right of a student to bring an animal to school, such as a support animal or animal for the blind, shall be determined in accordance with applicable law.</p> <p>2. Delegation of Responsibility The Superintendent shall develop administrative regulations for the implementation of this policy.</p> <p>References: School Code – 24 P.S.
