709.1. VIDEO SURVEILLANCE	
1. Purpose	The Board recognizes the value of using video surveillance to promote safety and minimize disruptive behavior on school buses, in school buildings and on district property. Audio use is prohibited.
2. Authority	To help achieve these objectives, the Board authorizes use of visual monitoring equipment in school buses and in common areas on school property. Common areas shall include all areas of school buildings and grounds other than restrooms, locker rooms, nurse offices, counseling rooms, and areas designated primarily for staff use.
3. Guidelines	<p>The Board prohibits the use of webcams to observe students when students are not on school property.</p> <p>Parents/Guardians, students, and staff shall be notified annually that the district conducts video surveillance and they may be subject to video recording.</p> <p>Review of video recordings by parents/guardians and students shall be permitted in accordance with law and regulations.</p>

Delegation of Responsibility</p>	<p>The Superintendent shall develop administrative regulations to implement this policy.</p> <p>There will be times that surveillance issues will be managed by the Superintendent. The use of video surveillance equipment in school buildings and district property shall be supervised and controlled by the building principal for routine matters.</p>
