INSTRUCTIONAL SUPPLIES</p> <p>Staff members and students are to be provided with the supplies and equipment that are deemed necessary for implementation of the approved educational program and subject to such reasonable conditions and requirements imposed by the Superintendent and stated in applicable administrative regulations.</p> <p>Students may be required to provide certain supplies or equipment for participation in extracurricular activities or educational programs, unless such requirements are prohibited under Applicable Law.</p> <p>When individualized and nonreusable clothing or equipment is necessary for reasons of safety or health, students shall be required to provide their own clothing or equipment, which shall meet state, federal or national standards set by the school. Such standards shall be reasonably related to considerations of safety, health and protection of property.</p> <p>When provision of instructional supplies imposes a financial hardship on a student, the School District may assume the cost.</p> <p>The Superintendent shall establish administrative regulations to implement this policy and to ensure that no student is denied participation in the educational program for financial reasons and to guard the privacy of each student.</p> <p>References:</p> <p>School Code – 24 P.S.
