Mr. Reinboth led the group in the Pledge of Allegiance.

ELECTION OF TEMPORARY PRESIDENT

Mr. Reinboth asked for nominations for Temporary President.

Mrs. Mueller nominated Mr. Miller as Temporary President.

Dr. Pollock nominated Mr. Hezel as Temporary President.

A motion was made by Mrs. Mueller and seconded by Dr. Pollock to close the nominations for Temporary President.

Mr. Hezel asked that the record show that there was a unanimous vote for Mrs. Huf as Assistant Secretary.

A motion was made by Dr. Pollock and seconded by Mrs. Lynch to adjourn the meeting. The motion passed 9-0. The meeting was adjourned at 7:25 p.m.
