Welcome and Introductions

Mrs. Schrader Lynch called the meeting to order at 7:00pm and welcomed all in attendance. Mrs. Schrader Lynch congratulated Dr. Susan Klyman on earning her doctoral credentials. Also, Mrs. Schrader Lynch congratulated Dr. Dunar and Dr. Mumin for their addition and future service to the Education Committee.

Presentations by School Principals and School Opening
