LESSON PLANS</p> <p>It is found that planning for instruction is fundamental to the success of the teaching/learning process and the sound operation of District schools. To ensure consistency and continuity of instruction, teachers are required to develop and maintain daily lesson plans consistent with this policy, applicable administrative regulations and the requirements of the applicable building principal.</p> <p>To facilitate more effective instruction, lesson plans must be prepared in advance. Plan books are subject to inspection by administrators.</p> <p>Teachers shall make thorough preparation for all daily lessons and shall prepare written plans reflecting such preparation.</p> <p>Teachers are required to develop emergency lesson plans to provide adequate directions for substitutes, the purpose of which shall be to continue the instructional program or provide a meaningful educational alternative that relates to the subject area.</p> <p>Emergency lesson plans must remain on the teacher's desk overnight to be available to substitute teachers at all times.</p> <p>The Superintendent shall establish administrative regulations for the implementation of this policy.</p> <p>References:</p> <p>School Code – 24 P.S.
