CAREER AND TECHNICAL EDUCATION</p> <p>A program of career and technical education shall be provided in order to:</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. Prepare students for employment as skilled workers or technicians in recognized, new and emerging occupations. 2. Prepare students for enrollment in postsecondary education programs. 3.
