RELATIONS WITH LAW ENFORCEMENT AGENCIES</p> <p>The Board recognizes that compulsory attendance laws impose on the Board the custodianship of District students while they are present in the schools.</p> <p>It shall be the policy of the Board that cooperation with law enforcement agencies is considered essential for protecting students and staff, maintaining a safe environment in schools, and safeguarding District property.</p> <p>The District shall encourage cooperation with law enforcement staff to present programs and activities designed to enrich District curriculum and to develop and promote good citizenship and a respectful attitude toward law enforcement officials.</p> <p>The Superintendent shall form an advisory committee composed of principals, school police officers, school counselors, special education administrators and other relevant school personnel to assist in the development of a memorandum of understanding with local law enforcement officials.</p> <p>The Superintendent, in consultation with the advisory committee, shall enter into a memorandum of understanding with local police departments having jurisdiction over school property. The memorandum of understanding shall meet the requirements of law and regulations and be executed, signed, updated and filed with the Office for Safe Schools in accordance with law and regulations.</p> <p>References:</p> <p>School Code – 24 P.S.
