239-AR-0. FOREIGN EXCHANGE STUDENTS

Eligibility of Foreign Exchange Students

1. Applications by foreign exchange students must be submitted to the Assistant Superintendent by July 1 for the upcoming academic school year.
2. The Centennial School District will accept foreign exchange students who are placed with a host family residing in the District.
3. The Centennial School District will accept foreign exchange students who have been vetted by a nationally recognized organization that coordinates study abroad programs. The vetting process must include the following:
 - a. An English proficiency assessment,
 - b. Good academic standing in the home school,
 - c. A support program from the student and host family,
 - d. Procurement of a student VISA, and
 - e. All immunizations and documentation required by the District.
4. Foreign exchange students are not eligible to attend charter or private schools, at the District's expense, while enrolled in the District as a foreign exchange student.
5. Foreign exchange students are not eligible for English as a Second Language instruction within the District.

Enrollment of Foreign Exchange Students

1. Foreign Exchange students are eligible for enrollment at William Tennent High School as a ninth, tenth, eleventh, or twelfth grade student.
2. Foreign exchange students must be enrolled by a District resident (Reference CSD Policy [200-ARs](#)). The District resident will complete the Affidavit of Responsibility application (Reference CSD Policy [202-AR-1](#)).
3. The Assistant Superintendent will review the foreign exchange student's VISA.
4. Foreign exchange students are eligible to attend William Tennent High School for one or two semesters per academic school year. Enrollment is not to extend beyond one school year.

Curriculum and Programming

1. A foreign exchange student may only attend William Tennent High School during the period of matriculation. The foreign exchange student will receive an academic schedule that complements the student's academic program from the home school.
2. A foreign exchange student may participate in extracurricular programs offered by the District in accordance with all established School Board policies and procedures and William Tennent High School procedures.
