Guidelines</p>	<p style="text-align: center;">110.1 USE OF CALCULATORS</p> <p>Recognizing that the use of calculators in school will ensure that students' experiences will match the realities of everyday life and develop reasoning skills, the Board recommends the integration of the calculators into the school program at all appropriate grade levels in classwork, homework and evaluation.</p> <p>The Superintendent shall develop administrative regulations for the implementation of this policy.</p> <p><u>High School</u></p> <p>Calculators shall be used as part of the classroom instructional program, the homework program, and the evaluation program, where applicable.</p> <p>All high school students shall obtain a calculator appropriate for the level of instruction. The high school administration shall inform students in advance of the requirement for a calculator.</p> <p>In those cases when a student cannot afford a calculator, the District shall lend the required calculator to the student, who shall accept full responsibility for replacing it if lost, stolen or damaged.</p> <p><u>Middle And Elementary Schools</u></p> <p>Students at the middle schools and the elementary schools shall have access to School District calculators for classroom instruction.</p> <p>Students shall be responsible for replacing School District calculators that are lost, damaged or stolen.</p> <p>Students shall be encouraged to obtain calculators for home use.</p>
