SAFETY

I. Objectives

- A. Instructional materials, equipment, tools, machines, and vehicles shall be maintained in good working condition.
- B. An unsafe condition or practice reported to a member of the building safety committee shall be corrected.
- C. Safe work practices and procedures shall continue to be studied and developed.
- D. The District shall comply with federal, state, and local laws regarding accident prevention.

II. Delegation of Responsibility

Responsibility for developing, directing and coordinating all safety policies and activities rest with the District Safety Committee. The success of any accident prevention program depends on the continuing and sincere efforts of all members of the Centennial School District community.

III. Procedures

- A. The District Safety Committee and the building administrators shall oversee the implementation of the Safety Policy, encourage safety awareness, investigate accidents, conduct inspections, and make recommendations concerning safety related items. This committee shall be appointed by the Facilities Manager and should represent a cross-section of the District staff. The committee shall include ten to twelve members.
- B. Building safety committees shall be established in each District building to assist with the implementation of the Safety Policy. This committee will interface with the District Safety Committee and:
  - 1. promote increased awareness of safety issues
  - 2. serve as a mechanism for reporting safety concerns
  - 3. perform periodic site inspections
  - 4. resolve building-level concerns
  - 5. refer unresolved building concerns to the District Safety Committee
